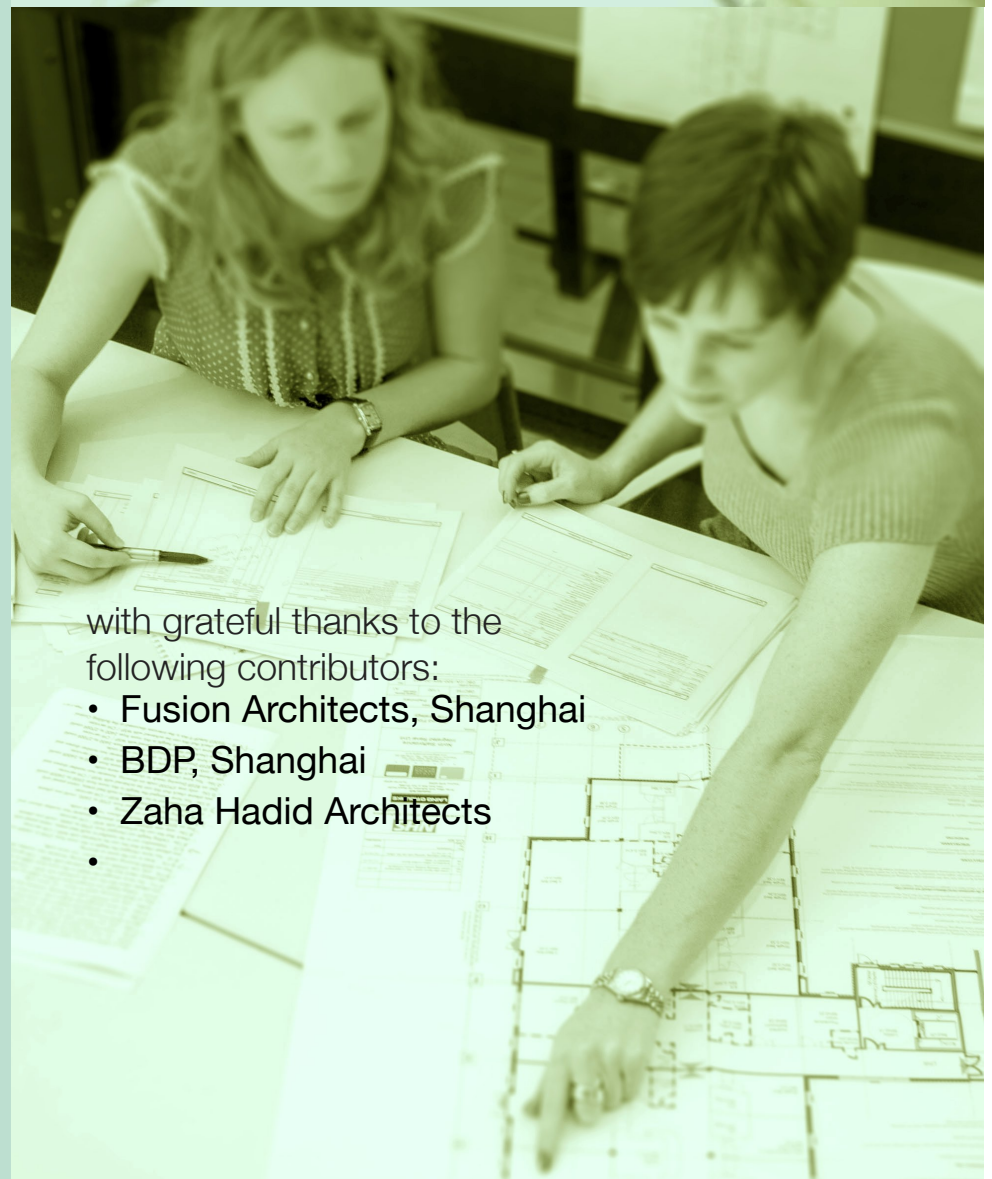
These resources include guidance and support on the following:
