

Reiteration on Fair Use of e-Resources at XJTLU Library

During the past few weeks, the Library received the alert notice several times from the publisher that there was fraudulent access to a database from XJTLU end users. The abnormal activities has resulted in the block of university's access to e-resources as well as damaged the university's reputation among publishers.

XJTLU Library subscribes to thousands of electronic journals and bibliographic databases for use by authorized users in the university. The terms and conditions for using these resources are spelled out in electronic resource license agreements with each publisher. It is the responsibility of individual users to ensure that the use of electronic resources does not breach the terms and conditions specified in the license agreements. In order to avoid the re-occurrence of any violations, the Library hereby reemphasizes the fair use of e-resources at XJTLU Library.

It is noted that the general principles on fair use of library's e-resources are as follows:

- Electronic resources such as e-journals, e-databases, e-books made available by XJTLU Library are for academic use.
- These resources can be searched, browsed and material may be downloaded and printed
 as single copies of articles. Downloading or printing of an entire issue or a volume of one
 or more journals (called systematic downloading) is strictly prohibited.
- Use of robots, spiders or intelligent agents to access, search and/or systematically download from these resources is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this policy will result in penal action as per the rules and regulations of the University.
- Please be aware that systematic downloading will cause the publisher to block to the entire community of users at XJTLU from accessing these resources.
